What is new in the area of layout construction?

We found a couple of tracks in the Capital Grain Company that were missing electrical drops. Joe has fixed that problem. We had a diode problem in West Fork that needs attention and hopefully we be fixed by the time you read this.

I have been adding scenery material in and around the small Handley Yard, Capital Grain Co and around the curve toward Port Allen Industrial area. Soon I will be adding ballast to the tracks in that area. I will also be working on the grain truck access road to the company.







The industry is looking pretty good!

Joe has been adding to the Capital Grain Company silos and the industry is starting to look very good.

Gene is adding to the scenery around the Cimarron saw mill log dump tracks and is in the process of coming up with some type of structure to aid the dumping of logs from the cars into the log pond.

Stu has been adding more scenery in the West Fork trackside industries.

Tom continues to hide under the layout working on the Gulf & Denver staging yards and the switch panels.

Bob is working on the retainment structure around the remaining oil holding storage tank.
